Aloha Region Regionals and Bid Playoffs

Tournament Update – April 1, 2022

TOURNAMENT DATE CHANGE:

The Aloha Region Regionals will now be a two-day event and will be held April 15 and 16. Thus we will be able to reduce the tournament entry fee to \$400.00. Those teams that are participating in the "bid" playoff may find doing both the tournament and the playoff for the bid a more affordable event. There will not be any scheduling conflicts if entering both events.

Teams that have already submitted their entry fees will receive a check for the difference in entry fees.

Clarification: Aloha Region Regionals vs Aloha Region Bid Playoffs

Each are separate events. Both events will be conducted over the same weekend. There will *NOT* be a scheduling conflict, so teams will be able to enter both events. We anticipate the bid playoffs will be held on Saturday AM. The play schedule will be determined by the number of teams entered into the Bid Playoffs. Tournament play will be scheduled around this event.

- 2. COVID Protocols have been dropped as of midnight March 25, 2022
 - a. Face masks are optional
- 3. Team rosters You may opt to use the attached excel spreadsheet in lieu of creating a roster in Sports Engine.
- 4. Reminder Outside Food and Drinks are not allowed in the play area player water bottles are okay. Meeting Rooms 301 A and B have been set aside for teams to use to snack, hydrate and hang out during the tournament. Please clean up after using the area.

Team check-in will be available on <u>April 14, 2022 from 12:00 noon to 3:00 pm</u> at the Convention Center – Hall 1. Rosters maybe changed until 8:00 am on April 15, 2022. Credentials for coaching staff will be handed out at this time. Credentials will be required for entry into the Exhibition Hall I.

- Team check-in will also be available on the day of the tournament located on the far right table facing the Exhibition Hall.
- 5. Pre-sale is unfortunately not available. Admission tickets will be available at the door. Cost will be \$20.00 for a one-day pass; \$35.00 for a two-day pass. (Children under 12 are free.)
- 6. Tournament Format and Other Changes There was a lot of confusion over the scheduling and we are so very sorry for the stress and inconveniences this caused. In order to alleviate some of the confusion we will need re-format the Aloha Region Regional tournament requiring a minimum of 6 teams in a division. If short, the teams will be combined into the next higher age division. They WILL NOT be separated out on the final day.

<u>The 10 and under division with 5 or less teams – all their matches will be played on 1</u> <u>day. Six or more teams will be played over two days.</u>

The <u>Adult Men and Women divisions will be cancelled</u> for this tournament. Next available tournament will be during the Aloha Summer Classic. – May 28, 29, 30, 2022.
